The Process of Supernatural Transformation

All of the activities and works of Jesus here on earth were (and still are) the display of His Father's heart. Everything He did was awesome and it was **ALL GOOD!**

Acts 10:38, in God's Word declares that, "*God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.*"

If we as children of our Father desire to display His heart, then we must do what Jesus did. Walking in the Supernatural, operating in miracles and destroying the works of the devil, simply reveal the Father's nature. Pastor Bill Johnson of Bethel Church (Redding Cal.) adds that in these revelations, there is embedded an **INVITATION FOR RELATIONSHIP**.

Miracles are like a magnet that draw us as His people and the world to want to know Him more. Our Heavenly Father is **ALL POWERFUL, SO AWESOME, TOTALLY SUPERNATURAL, WONDERFULLY CREATIVE** and He has put His nature inside of us!

In 2 Peter 1: 3-4, we read that by knowing Jesus who called us by His glory and virtue (**HIS DIVINE POWER**) we have been given "*exceedingly great and precious promises*" and that through these promises we are made partakers of **HIS DIVINE NATURE**. The process of being transformed to have more of His Supernatural nature in us is our task at hand. Therefore as believers and representatives of our Lord Jesus, as citizens of Heaven, let us allow His Holy Spirit's Power to transform us and flow His life through us.

One of the great challenges for every child of God is dealing with the devil, our defeated enemy. Scripture is very clear that he is real and that we are to resist him or oppose him **ALWAYS**. (1 Peter 5: 8,9; James 2: 19; 4: 7). We must always have our hearts established in God's Word of grace and truth. And the truth is **THE DEVIL IS DEFEATED!** (Col. 2:13-15)

However, he still is seeking to steal, kill and destroy (Jn. 10:10) and he does this through trying (scheming) to deceive people into believing his lies. The more we know Jesus, truly experience intimate fellowship with our God and King, the better equipped we will be to deal with devils.

Destroying the works of the devil should never be our main focus, nor should miracles be what captures our hearts. That high place is given to God Himself, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Yet these activities are those which Jesus walked in and has called us to do the same (Matt. 10:7,8).
